

School Without Hate PEACE Checklist

ASCHOOLWITHOUTHATE

To become a School Without Hate, your school must complete the tasks for each of the five categories. These activities range from school-wide, to classroom and at the individual student level. The tasks vary in difficulty. The tasks work together to improve the culture and climate of your school, creating a positive school environment in which all students feel valued and respected - a School Without Hate.

P - Pledge	Have 80% of your school's students sign a School Without Hate Banner pledging to improve the climate and culture of your school
E - Environment	Complete a school-wide activity from the Recipeace Cards OR: Transform the environment by hanging posters with messages of peace and non-violence at your school, doing an "I am wall" or doing your own school-wide initiative!
A - Action	Get as many students as possible to wear white on April 24 th - Day Without Hate
C - Challenges	Complete a culture and climate activity in each homeroom OR other classroom . Activities are found in the Recipeace cards or Building Connections Facilitator Guide.
E - Educate	Show students the bullying policy film created by the Student Health Advisory Council. Link to video: #lifewithouthate
